Fine for vio- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That if any person or persons shall use any sink boats, sneak boats or floats, in any of the waters of Back river, Middle river, Dundee, Salt Petre, Seneca creek, and their tributary streams in Baltimore county, while engaged in shooting at or killing wild ducks or other wild fowl, he or they shall be subject to a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each and every offence, and all things hereinafter enumerated which shall have been used in violation of this law shall be forfeited, that is to say, the sink boats, sneak boats, crafts or floats, the gun or guns, ammunition, and all other property found in the possession or use of such person or persons, at the time of the arrest and seizure, together with the boat, craft or float, and all things on board or belonging to the same, employed to convey the said person or persons to any

of the aforesaid waters, for the purpose or use of any or all the above enumerated articles, in the manner afore-
