SEC. 3. And be it enacted. That whenever the said One or more corporation may become possessed of one or more mines mines. in Baltimore county, in this State or elsewhere, the directors of said company may make a separate and distinct interest of each mine, and direct the operation of, and control and manage the said mine under such rules and regulations as they may deem expedient and proper, and may divide said interest in such number of shares as they may deem expedient, of the value of not less thae five dollars each, and may declare and pay dividends on the shares in any of the said mines, in such manner as the provisions of this act and the bylaws of the company may direct.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the persons named Subscription in the first section of this act, or any two of them, be books to be and they are hereby authorised, to open books for subscriptions to the stock of the company, at such places as they may deem expedient, and after five thousand shares shall have been subscribed for, to call a first meeting of subscribers to said stock, for the purpose of organizing the company and framing by-laws for its regulation and government, at which meeting, and at all subsequent meetings of stockholders, each stock. holder shall be entitled to give in person, or by proxy constituted in writing, one vote for every share of capital stock standing in his or her name on the books of the company.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act Banking forshall be so construed as to allow the said corporation bid. to issue any note, token scrip or device to be used as a currency.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That this act of incor- In force. poration shall take effect from the date of its passage.
