SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That said company Authority to shall have full power and authority to make and lay lay conduits. conduits or tunnels for the conveyance of said water under, along the streets, lanes, alleys and side pavements or any of them, of the town of Frostburg for the purpose of conveying and distributing said water, and the said conduits or tunnels from time to time to renew and repair, leaving at the same time as sufficient passage for carriage, horses or foot passengers as the case may be and forthwith restoring to their former condition all such streets, lanes, alleys and side pavements as may at any time be dug, opened or taken up.
