their term of service, as if the requisitions of said act had been complied with in due time.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take in force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 315.

AN ACT to authorise the Board of Directors of the Passed May Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys, to 27, 1853.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Authority to That the board of directors of the Baltimore Manual increase number of School for Indigent Boys, incorporated by an ber of directors of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter two hundred and forty seven, be, and they are hereby authorised to increase the number of directors from nine, the number prescribed in the said act of incorporation, to any number not exceeding eighteen, which the said board of directors may, from time to time, fix upon and determine; Provided however, that any five of the board of directors, shall continue to form a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Pension alof Maryland, That Susan King, of Allegany county, lowed. widow of George King, late of Allegany county, a private in the American Revolution, be, and she is hereby allowed a pension equal to half pay of a private, in
