

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer be, Authority to

## CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT relating to Writs of Diminution.

Passed March  
21, 1853.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* Duty of infe-  
*of Maryland*, That upon every writ of diminution that rior court.  
shall hereafter be issued by the Court of Appeals of  
this State, to any inferior court, it shall be the duty of  
such inferior court to certify and return only such parts  
of the record or proceedings as shall have been omitted  
in the transcript or transcripts therefore transmitted to  
the Court of Appeals.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That every application Specification  
for a writ of diminution, shall contain a specification  
in writing, of the parts of the records or proceedings re-  
quisite to be supplied, which shall also be incorporated  
in the writ of diminution for the guidance of the inferior  
court.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the issuing of a Not to delay

Court of Appeals of any cause, in case the return there- cause.  
to be made before the said cause, shall be called for  
hearing unless for good cause shewn.
