Passed May 5, 1853. Resolution in favor of the late Commissioner of Loans.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That in the settlement of the accounts of the late Commissioner of Loans, the Comptroller allow as a credit to said commissioner the sum of three thousand and eighty-eight dollars and twenty-six cents, for expenses of his office from the year eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, to the year eighteen hundred and fifty-two.
