

272. An act to incorporate the Frostburg and Western Post Plank Road Company.

273. An act to incorporate the Worcester Railroad Company.

274. An act to incorporate the Trustees of the Sheppard Asylum.

275. An act to incorporate the School Commissioners of Carroll county, and to amend an act for the better regulation of primary schools in Carroll county, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-two, chapter one hundred and sixty-eight.

276. An act to lay out and locate a public road in Worcester county.

277. An act granting leave to carry into effect the bequest or devise in the will of Sally Jones, deceased.

278. An act to extend the time of the Assessors of Montgomery county, to complete the assessment.

279. An act to reorganise the Common Schools of Saint Mary's county, and to levy a tax for the support of the same.

280. An act to divide the State into six Congressional districts.

281. An act amendatory of an act passed January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-two, chapter three hundred and fifty-six, entitled an act for the removal of the live stock scales in the City of Baltimore, to Baltimore county.

282. An act to appropriate a sum of money to be applied to the erection of a suitable foot and head stone over the remains of Henry M. Godwin, late member of the House of Delegates, from Caroline county.

283. An act to incorporate the Preachers Fund Society, of the City of Baltimore.

284. An act for the relief of the sureties on the bonds of James J. Chew, former collector of Prince George's county.

285. An act to incorporate the Catocin Savings Institution.

286. An act to pay to Israel Norris, collector of the State taxes for Carroll county, for the year eighteen hundred and forty-five, a sum of money as an equivalent for his insolvencies allowed by the Commissioners of said county, for the year aforesaid.

287. An act making valid certain proceedings of Absalom W. Sparks, late a constable of Kent county, authorising him to return certain proceedings against Perry Frisby, and a report of the sale of real estate, to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Kent county, and to authorise the said Court to order a deed to be made of said real estate to A. H. Crew and John L. Crew, of Kent county.
