

In The Fear & Dread of Almighty God Amen this fourteenth day of the sixth month called August in the year of our Lord 1609 Honney Egglammyn of Little field in the County of Somersit and Province of Maryland being weak in body but of good and perfect memory thanks be to Almighty God doe make & ordaine this my last will & Testament in manner & forme following annulling and making voyd all other Wills and Testaments by me formerly made and this only to be taken for my last will & Testament And first of all I calling to remembrance that all flesh must dye and yeeld to death when it shall please God to call. I bequeath my soule to Almighty God my maker believing through the Meritts of Jesus Christ assuredly to be saved and to have full remission & forgiveness of all my sins and that my soule with my body shall rise againe glorified at the generall day of resurrection with joy and my body to be buried in such decent manner as my friends shall thinke meet

And now for the setting of my temporall estate and such goods Chattels and debts as it hath pleased God for above my desert to bestowe upon me I doe order give & dispose the same in manner & forme following that is to say first I will that all those rights and Duties due in right or conscience to any manner of person or persons be well & justly satisfied & the rest I dispose as followeth
Item I give unto my eldest sonne Honney Egglammyn to him & to his heires for ever all that plantacon with its rights & priviledges wherein I now dwell as also unto my sonne Thomas & John & to their heires for ever by Equall division all that four hundred acres of land by me lately taken up called Gallaway

And my will is that my loving wife Ellen Egglammyn shall have her Lifer right in y^e said land for y^e educating & bring up of the other two sons And in case my wife should dye before my three sons come to age then my will & pleasure and desire is that John Drevitt may be assistant to y^e survivors of them for y^e educating & bringing them up

Item I will y^e the small stock: vizt four cows & five calves & one yearling heifer remaine upon y^e said plantacon and be afoyned stock amongst my wife & her three sons vizt: Honney Thomas & John Egglammyn

Item I give unto my loving wife Ellen Egglammyn one browne horse called Button

Item I give unto my sonne Honney one gray horse

Item I give fiftene sheepe unto my wife & my three sons as aneane flock to goe amongst them only my will is that the next yearning time there be given out of the same one ewe & Lamb unto my daughter Ellen and one ewe and Lamb unto my daughter Elizabeth

Item I will that when my daughter Ann goeth to house keeping her mother shall give her two good sows with Pigg for breeders

Item I give unto my loving wife all other movables being in my house whatsoever for and toward the bringing up of my three sons whene I make at age as they shall respective accomplish the age of twenty one years

Doe therefore give and grant unto you the said Ellen Egglammyn full power and authority to administer all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased and to demand collect and receive and in legal manner require and receive all and all manner of debt and debts due and owing to the said deceased and well & faithfully to dispose of the same and out of the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased whome have may or shall come to you her or possessions well & truly to pay the debts due by the said deceased so far forth as the same will hereunto extend and the Law will charge you according to y^e true value of the same And of You having first taken yo^r oath well & truly to administer the same and to make or cause to be made true & perfect Inventory of all singular y^e goods and Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which may have or shall
