MEMORANDUM That this day viz the 18 day of March in the third year of their Majesties Reign William and Mary King and Queen over England &c. came before us two of their Majesties Justices of the Peace for the County of Somerset, the within mentioned William: Cuthbert and Anne his wife parties to the within written Indentures, and the said Anne being a part from her said husband and let to say examined according to act of assembly in that case made and provided, did at newbridge the within mentioned Anne Cuthberts intent to be the right of him the within named Robert Cuthbert and his heirs and assigns for ever. To age them the said William and Anne and their heirs and assigns they will for ever warrant the same having to full satisfaction to all intents & purposes finally by these presents.

Whereas by these presents that I William Cuthbert of the County of Somerset and Province of Maryland Gent do acknowledge and confess my self to owe and am indebted unto Robert Cuthbert of the same County & Province aforesaid but the sum of five hundred pounds sterling money of England, which I promise to pay to the abovesaid Robert Cuthbert or to his certain attorney, or to his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, and for the true performance of the same to be well and truly paid, I bind me my heirs executors administrators finally by these presents in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 18th day of March in the 3. year of their Majesties Reign Wm and Mary over England, Scotland France & Ireland King and Queen defenders of the faith &c. Anne Domini 1690

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the within bound William Cuthbert shall upon the reasonable request to him to be made by the within named Robt Cuthbert his heirs or assigns on the first day of September next ensuing the date within written Indenture and after unto the said Robert Cuthbert his heirs and assigns for ever, a certain tract of Land called Stables Field containing fifty five acres fifteen rods from him &c the said Cuthbert his heirs & assigns for ever, all which premises are lying and being upon the South side of the River as appears by a certain Survey made under the hand and seal of him the said Wm Cuthbert bearing date with these presents which is fifty five acres fifteen rods with all and singular its premises w^{ch} if appurtenances. God further by these presents warrant and defend to him the said Robert Cuthbert and to his heirs for ever from me my heirs for ever in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above expressed
