all and every of the Heirs of the said Mathew that he do have the same within mentioned Indenture addition to first purchase
of fifty Acres more or less unto her the said Hannah & her Heirs and Assigns against them the said Elizabeth Cook. John Cook &
Mathew his wife in their Heirs and assigns every the Heirs of the said Mathew with warrant and defence for ever, and
for their acknowledgment Quitt Claim & acquittance, the said Hannah hath given them eight thousand pounds of
tobacco;

THIS Indenture made the fourth day of September in the year of our Lord God, One thousand six
hundred and ninety SEVEN. James Cullen of St. Maries County in the Province of Maryland, Executor of
the last will and Testament of Mark Corda of the same County and Province deceased of the one part. And
Nicholas Mountaine of Somerset County in the said Province of the other part. WITNESSETH that whereas the said
Mark Corda in his life time was seized and possessed of a certain tract or parcel of Land called now Runnys
lynch on the Eastermost side of Chesapeake Bay in the County of Somerset in a North of Land lying between
Annonas River and Monocin River in a Marsh called Runnys Marsh. Beginning for length at the Northernmost
side of a Creek called Winder Creek, and at the Eastermost side of a small gutt issuing out of the said Creek
near unto which is a marked Tree, and from the said gutt running North east Northwesterly for length two hundred
Seaboardly five perches to a pine stump that is marked standing in the Marsh, and from thence running for breadth
South east Easterly unto five perches to a Lotust Stake standing in the Marsh that is marked, and from
thence running for length two hundred Seaboardly five perches South west Southwesterly to the side of the Creek called
Winder Creek, and from thence running down the said Creek to the first bend towards the Eastermost end of said
Land upon a Ridge lies a parcel of Land called the last Time taken up by Ambrose London containing ten Acres &

hundred and fifty Acres more or less which land is part of Land the said Mark Corda by his last will and
