Hence by Order of Court this tenth day of November in the fourth year of their Majesties Reign William & Mary by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King & Queen & Defenders of the faith &c. and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety and One. -

EMENDAT **County in Maryland:** Do hereby you ^{impose} Cap. John. Brosten and in Stephen Luffe to appraise the goods and Chattels of m. William. Brosten deceased. You having first taken your Oath before C. Dabie Browne One of their Majesties Justices of the Peace for this County and you are to certify the true value of the said goods and Chattels (appraised in money) under your hands and seals into our County Court to be returned the second Tuesday in June next at the furthest after the date hereof. This is the Order of Court dated the tenth day of November in the fourth year of their Majesties Reign William and Mary by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King and Queen defenders of the faith &c. and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety and One.
