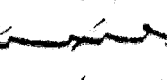
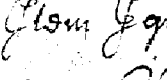
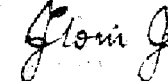
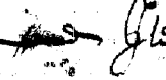
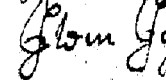
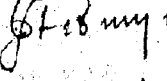


With such intreats. The said of my Computation fifty shillings, also to be paid him by my Executor at twenty

out with a straight line to the first corner the marked stake with eight Notches. To have and to hold the

both male and female after my decease, also two Sow sheals with their future intreats, and the first till

or Calf by her side, Two Sow sheals with their intreats for ever, and my Mars Motts with her intreats
for ever. (Excepted as before excepted) also I give and bequeath further unto my said daughter Anne
Beauchamp, Two thousand pounds of tobacco to be paid her the next Crops following after her day
of marriage as also one Cow with her intreats. 
Now I bequeath unto my son Dogot Beauchamp
One Cow and Calf and her intreats for ever, the male excepted to my son Thomas untill eighteen years
of age, then both male and female and to enjoy at his proper goods for ever with five hundred pounds of
tobacco to be paid him by my Executor at the age of twenty years, as also One Cow with her intreats. —
Now I give and bequeath unto my son Edward Beauchamp, One Cow and Calf and their intreats for ever
the male excepted as before untill eighteen years of age then both male and female, and to enjoy at his
proper goods for ever, with five hundred pounds of tobacco to be paid him by my Executor at the age of twenty
years, and One Cow with her intreats. 
Now I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Beauchamp
One Cow Calf, the said Cow Calf to be paid him and delivered to him up at the age of ten years and if it die
to deliver him another untill such time as a Cow and Calf by her side the male intreats at
before to my son Thomas untill eighteen years of age then the said Robert to enjoy both male and female at his
proper goods for ever, & I also give him four hundred pounds of tobacco to be paid him by my Executor at
twenty years of age, and One Cow with her intreats. 
Now I give and bequeath unto Robert Beauchamp
two hundred pounds in money to be paid her at the day of Marriage.
