

Know all men by these presents that we Thomas Deauhamp, Miles Gray and Mary Fountaine of the County of Dorset and Robins of Maryland Subj^m for at New Bedford and on the 1st of Feb^r 1691 to our said and inclosed into their Majties King William and Queen Mary Over England Fra for Bank of the City of London Edmund Deauhamp etc, the sum of two hundred pounds sterling money of England where we promise to pay to their Majties or to their assigns for redemp^t a record, and for y^e his perform^{ance} of the same to be well and truly paid us and our heirs, Executors and assigns jointly and severally in and for the whole. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the first day of February: in the fourth year of their Majties Reign. Anno Domini 1691

THE CONDITION of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Deauhamp do well and truly observe, and satisfy all and every the will of Edmund Deauhamp etc, who the said Will bears date the 2nd day of April Anno: 1691. He will as to pay all and every the debts of y^e said deceased, upon Order had and obtained from their Majties Justices of the Peace in Court sitting at also to observe the Laws and Statutes, in the said letters of Administration, and to make no waste sale or destruction, ne of or upon the real Estates of Orphans viz, dwelling houses, lands, woods, Orchards and grounds. Observing that Law substituted, due d^t for probatation of Orphans real Estates and lastly to keep harmless and indemnify the Justices of the Peace of the said County for Probate of Wills and granting of Administrations, and all other the Officers therein concerned. That then this present Obligation to be void and of none effect. Otherwise to stand and remaine in full power force and virtue.
