The condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound William Breerton doe well & truly serve their Ma^{ties} their heires & successors in the office of high Sheriff of Sommersett County and shall rend^{er} unto their said Ma^{ties} or other their Ma^{ties} officers true faithful and perfect am^{ts} of all and singular their Ma^{ties} rents and other fees and dues that he shall be intrusted with by their said Ma^{ties} or any of their officers within this Province to receive and collect and his am^{ts} to their said Ma^{ties} heires and successors for his rents and fines forfeitures or other dues belonging to their Ma^{ties} and also his am^{ts} of all fees dues or damages of Colonos for Levies or fees due to any of their Ma^{ties} officers within this Province shall pay and give an am^{ts} of at the City of S^t Martin in y^e Province aforesaid in his owne proper person by the first Tuesday in April next ensuing the date hereof and in all other things as Sheriff of the said County shall behaue himselfe well & honestly as well towards their said Ma^{ties} as to all other persons whatsoever then this obligation to be void or else remaine in force
