

This Bill of Josias Seaward Planter of Somerset County in his Executions of Maryland in my hands Executors and assigns to pay or cause to be paid unto John Loader of Somerset County aforesaid the sum of six hundred and thirty two and $\frac{3}{4}$ bushels of wheat one hundred and fifty pounds of good sound Merchantable loaf tobacco of the Continent at Somerset River in Somerset County at or upon the twenty day of October Ensignia the said Loader did witness my hand and seal this sixteenth day of May 1687 - - - - - Josias Seaward & Seal

Upon a Part of this Bill was writ as followeth -
Read this 7. June 1688. in part of this Bills Eighteen hundred & Sixty Six pounds tobacco & three bushels wheat I say now of John Loader -

M. Josias Seaward. the 17. July 1688

Shall to pay unto Richard Harwell, the Executor of this Bill that remains due, also two hundred pounds of tobacco you engaged to pay for Walter Lodge Chirurgion, & one hundred & ninety three pounds tobacco you engaged to pay me for your Brother Robinson at his Store, this with his receipt shall be your discharge for the same from your being bound.
