

This Indenture made the ninth day of January in the viiiij year of y' Dominion of the Al' Hen: Bl: Charles
 alblst: Lord & Prop: of y' Province of Maryland & duvalon Lord Baron of Baltimore and in the year of our Lord
 God one thousand six hundred eighty eight Between William Keene Sen: of Somersett County Sen: in the
 Province of Maryland plant: and chmne his wif: of thi: one part I Gd John Gosling of y' County & Province
 aforesaid plant: of y' other part witnesseth y' wherefore said Lord Baltimore by his Deed of Grant under his
 great seal: us'd in thi: said Province of Maryland for granting of Land there bearing date the eighth diversitie
 day of June in y' eight b'f thirteyn y' ar: of his Rapp: Dominion anno: 1669 did for y' Consideration
 aforesaid mentioned grant unto William Keene aforesaid alleys partell of Land called what you please lying on y
 east side of the se peak: bay in y' County of Somersett in a river called Mincemore on the Northw'ast side of y
 said River beginning for breadth at dimarkt white oak standing by abranch side called Mincemore branch
 near the mouth of y' said branch w: an outlet into the aforesaid river of Mincemore & from thence running up
 the side of y' s: river of aforesaid line one hundred & fifti: perches to y' mouth of abranch called Steene branch and
 from thence running up into y' wood: Northw'est westerly three hundred & Seventy perches bounded on the west
 with a line running Southwest from the end of the former line for breadth one hundred & fifty perches till it
 run to the length of all greater Mincemore and from thence running downe the said line to the first corner
 containing three hundred acres more or less together with all rights profits & benefits there unto belonging
 (royall Mincemore excepted) To have & to hold the s: p'ce of Land to him the s: William Keene his heires & assignes
 for ever vid: Such rents Covenants & covenants & covenants as in & by the s: Deed of grant aforesaid beinge tenanted
 had more fully & more at large it may & doth appear. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the abovesigned
 William Keene and chmne his wife for y' Consideration of three thousand pounds of tobacco in hand paid by y' within
 named John Gosling before the sealing & delivery hereof witnesseth thi: s: William Keene & chmne his
 wife hath acknowledged the same to be fully & wholly satisfied and paid and doth off: & for ever part & parcel
 thereof as ault & discharge y: s: John Gosling his heires & assignes & adm: for every part & parcel presents Hath given
 granted bargained and sold before & confirmed and doth by this present fully & absolutely give grants all and
 bargained sell enforfe: and confirmed unto thi: said John Gosling and to his heires & assignes for ever all that
 part or partell of Land being part of y' devident aforesaid called what you please running ab: followis (viz) beginning
 upon Robert Hardys Creek neare two span: stooke: running into y' wood: Northw'est halfe a mile westerly on land
 and y: partell from thence running to a markt white oak & from thence so marked y: one hundred & fifti:
 perches Southw'ast easelly to said oak one hundred & y: partell from thence to y: first corner laid land out for
 one hundred acres more or less: togh: ther with all & singular y' rooms Cellars follets Palls Parlours Chambers houling
 Courts yards gardens orchards (y: godes wood: underwood timber & timber like trees) w: eas: in: fishing place & other
 appurtenances emoluments whatsoever unto y' s: partell of Land containing one hundred acres more or less: being
 part of y' devident aforesaid (call'd what you please) or y' partell wherof of them appurtenant belonging or appertaining
 had vs'd demised or emoynd past partell or member of the rest or as heretofore or to any part therof belonging or
 appurtenant also to thi: s: William Keene chmne his wife for themselves their heires & assignes & adm:

 Scripts and Minuti: so hereby granted & sold by thi: s: William Keene & chmne his wife doth hereby agree to
 deliver or cause to be delivered to thi: s: John Gosling aforesaid his heires & assignes on thi: day of y' feare of s: Michael
 y' archangel last & undescared as now the same are To have and to hold the s: partell of Land bounded
 of one hundred acres more or less part of y' devident aforesaid & all & singular other y' partell by me mentioned
 to be bargained & sold & every of them with their & every appurtenant unto thi: s: John Gosling his
 heires & assignes To y: only proper use & behoof of y: s: John Gosling his heires & assignes for ever without
 any mortgag: condition redempcion yf: or suuitor to recall alre: charg: or determine y: same To be holder of
 y: A: Roy: Bl: y: Lord Prop: for & under such rents & services as by the original recited Deed of grant reserved
 & of right accustomed to be paid thereoff by thi: s: William Keene & chmne his wife for themselves their heires & assignes
 & adm: & every of them y: partell of Land of one hundred acres more or less being part of y' devident aforesaid
 with y' appurtenances before by this present bargained & sold unto him y: s: John Gosling doth for Ever fully
 assent & discharge the same of & from all manner & other & forme: bargaines faites to him selfe
 somwhat before & of and from all other debts incumbrances partie & demands whatsoeuer hee had
 made done committed omitted or willingly or unwillingly suffered or incurred by reason of y' Committee of safety or
 or procured by thi: s: William Keene chmne his wife Adm: his heires & assignes or by any of them or by any other
