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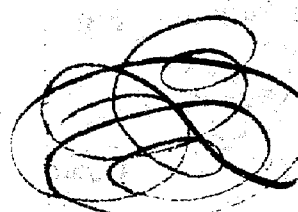

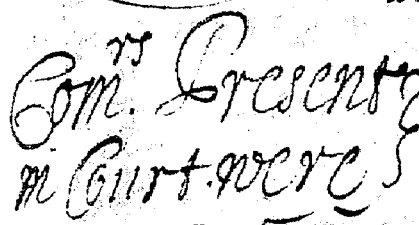
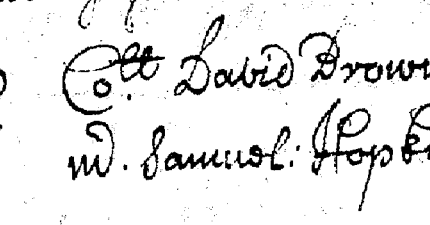

THE MOTION of the aforesd Rogerizans is such that if the aforesd bound Jeremiah Townsend be of the good behaviour & abstarine to all their Majties good people of this Province during the Courts pleasure then the Rogerizans to be bound of new oaths, otherwise to be remane in full power foris & bound. — — — — —
