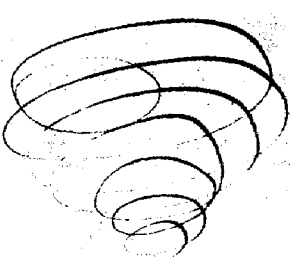


Maryland

 me & in my name and for my proper use, to ask demand & receive all such debt or debts that is
 or may come due unto me either by Bill, Bond or accounts or any other ways and if occasion served
 to sue & sue & impound any person or persons that is or shall be due unto me. and also to imprison
 or upon payment of either debt or debts to take out of prison. ratifying & confirming what my
 said Attorney shall lawfully do. to be as effectual as if I were personally present. And if occasion
 be, to make one or more Attorney or Attorneys as he shall think fit. do witness my hand & Seal this
 29th April. 1690

At a Court hold for the County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland by their Majties Justices
 of the Peace. the 12th day of January Anno Domini 1691.

Im present? in Francis: Gent. Maj Robert King. in James: Lom?
 in Court were Cap. John: King and in Stephen: Horsey. — — —

The Court being called 3 times. The Oath of Matrimony was then published by the Clerk of
 the Court between John: Judroll and Elmer: Abnanathan: it being the first time — and

Richard Chambers prayed this Court that Letters of Admⁱⁿ may be ordered him upon the Estate of
 Wm: Jones son of Charles Jones Esq. which by this Court is granted. and ordered that Charles Hall
 and Thomas: Wallsten be appraisers appointed and that Wm: Stephen: Horsey swear to appraisers. —

Ordered by the Court that the Overseers of Unswadde^o premises and the Inhabitants thereof for & with
 repairs the Bridge on this side become to Bridge beyond Dividing Creek: to Wm: Cowford Esq. done
 seal 9th

Edward: Sadbury was this day brought into Court, his mittimus was read and given to Grand Jury. and he being
 ordered into the Sheriff's custody. — where Grand Jury was that day summoned & returned whose names are
 as follows (e. viz) Cap. Wm: Coulbourn. Walter: Read. James: Lantoy John: Lops. Robert Johnson. Ga: Ingram.
 Henry: Myers. John: Carter. George: Goddard. John: Gray Thomas: Jordan Christopher: Nutter. Edward: Donnell.
 John: Martin. John: Walker. Moses: Gordon. who being duly returned & sworn upon the holy Evangelists to
 by the Cause depending between their Majties & the above Sadbury —
 Anthony: Galesmith & Henry Smith Clerks were sworn and Sadbury was put up to Grand Jury —
