Continuing with Inventory y^e are bound assigned to performe or at furthest at or before the second Tuesday in June next ensuing and audit. with in twelue months from the date of these presents. And lastly we doo hereby impower, constitute Ordain and appoint, y^e the said Richard Chambers dem of all and singular the goods Chattle & Credits of the said deceased this 12th day of January in the fourth year of their Majesties reign. and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety and One.
