quit of them the said John & Clementine his wife and for themselves their heires and the heirs of the
said John Parker remised and quit claime thereof to the said John Booth and his heires forever and
further the said John & Clementine have granted for them and their heires and all & every the heirs
of the said John & Clementine that the said Land within mentioned unto him the said John Booth and
his heires against them or either the said John and Clementine and their heires and all & every
heire of the said John & Clementine will warrant for ever and for this acknowledgement to make quitt
partie & agreement the said John Booth hath given them the said John and Clementine six thousand
pounds of tobacco

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of April anno^r Do^m 1690 and in the fourteenth year
of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland
and also Lord Baron of Baltimore or Between the Anthonys Underwood of St. Maries County in the
Province of Maryland and Martha his wife of the one part and Simon Persim of Potomack in the
County of Somers^t & Province aforesaid of the other Part witnesseth that whereas the said Lord
Baltimore by his Deed of grant under the great seal used in the said Province of Maryland for granting
of land there bearing date at the City of St. Maries in the said Province of Maryland for granting of the
14 day of May in the third year of his said Lordship's dominion over the said Province dñe^r Iohannes
one thousand six hundred & twenty eight did for the Confederates therein mentioned grant unto
Robert Ridgley of St. Maries County gentl all that part of land called Little Belair fortuate
lying & being on the east side of Chesapeake Bay on the south side of Comartiro river Bounded as by
said Patent may appear containing twelve hundred acres of land more or less and witnesseth the aforesd
Robert Ridgley by his last will & Testament bearing date at St. Maries City in the said Province the
twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord god one thousand six hundred & eighty six give grant
unto whose right and title of all the abovementioned lands of Little Belair to his wife Martha Ridgley
and to her heires and assignees for ever Ridgleyes that the said Anthony Underwood and Martha

herself for and in consideration of the just & full sume of forty pounds sterl and twenty shillings
pounds of good merchantable tobacco in hand paid and secured to be paid to them as also for divers
causes and considerations them more especially moving the recent and seruile of the
aforesaid man & tobacco the said Anthony Underwood and Martha his wife both hereby acknowledge
that hereby given grant remised sold and for ever quit claime enforst & confirmed by the
presente both give grant remise & sell release for ever quit claime enforst & confirmed unto the
said Anthony Underwood all their right title and interest of in & to y^e above mentioned tract of land called
Little Belair containing twelve hundred acres of land more or less together with all rents
wrecks & other rights Priviledges and benefites there onto belonging or in any way appertaining as
fully and aqually as is contained in y^e above recited Patent to have and to hold the same unto
the said Simon Persim and his heires to the only use & behalfe of the said Simon Persim his Person
or assignees for ever only paying & yelding to the said Lord Baltimore & his heires the yearly rents
as were & are required in the above recited Patent and the said Anthony Underwood and
