Memorandum that this day with the eleaventh day of March Anno Domini 1669 before us
Samuell Hopkins and Stephen Guffe two of his Ma^{ty} Justices of the Peace for the County of Somers
Came John Larher and Clemente his wife in there proper persons and the said Clemente being
alone & secretly examined by the sd Justices according to the forme of Overtame Act of Assembly
in that case made & Provided did acknowledge the said in y^e within written Indenture mentioned
to be the right of him the within named John Booth as that which the said John Booth hath of y^e
gift of them the said John & Clemente his wife and for them & there heirs and the heirs of the
said John have remised and quit Claime thereof to the said John Booth and his heirs for ever and
further the said John & Clemente have granted for them and their heirs and all & every the heirs
of the said John & Clemente that the said said within mentioned unto him the said John Booth and
his heirs against them against the said John and Clemente and their heirs and all & every he
heirs of the said John & Clemente will wairent for ever and for this acknowledgement & misse quit
Claime & agreement the said John Booth hath given them the said John and Clemente six thousand
pounds of tobaco

This Indenture made the sixteenth day of April Anno Domini 1660 and in the thirteenth year
of the Dominion of the Right honorable Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland
And Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore or Betweene Anthony Underwood of St. Maries County in the
Province of Maryland and Martha his wife of the one part And Simon Perkins of Potomack in the
County of Somerset Province aforesaid of the other part Whereof that whereas the said Lord
Baltimore by his Deed of grant and the great Seal used in the said Province of Maryland for granting
of land there bearing date at the City of St. Maries in the sd Province of Maryland bearing date the
14 day of May in the third year of his said Lordships Dominion over the said Province Anno Domini
one thousand six hundred seventy and eight did for the Consideration therein mentioned grant unto
Robert Redgely of St. Maries County gent^l all that parcel of Land called Little Belleau situate
lying & being on the east side of Chesapeake Bay on the south side of Tomartiro river bounded as by y^e
said Patent may appear containing Twelve hundred acres of Land more or less And whereas the aforesaid
Robert Redgely by his last will & Testament bearing date at St. Maries City in the said Province the
Twentyeth day of December in the year of our Lord 1658 one thousand six hundred eighty did give grant
his whole Right and Title of all the above mentioned Lands of Little Belleau to his wife Martha Redgely
and to her heirs and assigns for ever Whereof that the said Anthony Underwood and Martha
as well
knowing for and in consideration of the Just & full Summe of forty pounds first and Twenty thousand
pounds of good merchantable tobaco in hand paid and secured to be paid to them as also for divers
causes causes and Considerations them more especially moving the rest and security of the
aforesaid money & tobaco the said Anthony Underwood and Martha his wife doth hereby acknowledge
hath been given granted remised sold and for ever quit Claimed enfrested & confirmed & by this
present doth give grant remise & sell release for ever quit Claimed enfrested & confirmed unto the
said Simon Perkins all their Right Title and Interest of us to y^e above mentioned Tract of Land called
Little Belleau containing Twelve hundred Acres of Land more or less together with all Rights
orders & other Rights Priviledges and Benefitts thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining as
fully and amply as is contained in y^e above recited Patent to have and to hold the same unto
the said Simon Perkins and his heirs to the only use & behoofe of the said Simon Perkins his heirs
& assigns for ever only paying & yielding to the said Lord Baltimore & his heirs the yearly rent
in w^{ch} it required in the above recited Patent And the said Anthony Underwood and
Martha
