and for true performance of the same, we the above bounden, do by these presents bind us and our aforesd for the
which and in the which, with our hands and seals the third day of January. Anne Dom. 1691. In the
fourth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady William & Mary King & Queen of England
Scotland, France & Ireland.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bounden James English & Wm: Mason were
indicted by the Court of Judgments, by Order of Lazarus: Maddux of said County for Rogg & stealing, and being
brought to try all in said County Court in June last past and were found guilty of the fact, whereupon they obtained
a writ or Writ out of the High Court of Chancery for stopping Execution until further hearing before the
Court of said Liberties which is to be holden April next. Now the Condition is such that if the said English and
Mason shall make their personal appearance at said Court and their property to Writ of Error. that
then and in that case the above Obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise remaine void in full force & virtue.
