my soule unto god my creator hopeing thus through the meritorious works & death & passion of Jesu Christ
my Saviour and redeemer to receive free pardon and remission of all my sins, and my body to y' earth to be
buried in such Christianlike manner as my especiallise hereafter mentioned shall seeme most convenient
And as to such worldly estate as thi' Lord in mercy hath left me after my just debts & funeral expenses
discharged I doe disposse of as hereafter is mentioned and expresslie ordaining declaring & publishing the same
my last will & testament and disannulling and making void all former or other wills by me made /
In witness & bequath unto my son William Jones divers shillings sterling money or the value thereof taking
from thold ring

I give & bequeath unto my son Daniel Jones, Twenty shillings Sterling money in the Waller Geare to
buy him a hold Ring.

I give entomoy and bequeath unto my son John Jones and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever all that plantation with y lare therewith belonging situate lying & being upon Little Muncy, Creek in the County of Somerset aforesaid with all houses, Edifices, buildings yards orchards & inclosures therewere belonging beginning at a marked tree parting it from the land of George Mitchell from thence running up Little Muncy to the lands of John Parker from thence running half way through the swamp towards great Muncy from thence downe the swamp until it cometh to the line of the said George Mitchell and from thence

running to little money to the first bounder
My will & desire is that my loving wife Jane Jones after my decease doe peaceably and quietely occupy &
enjoy the plantation whericon you will with the house therin unto belonging together with all houses Edifices
