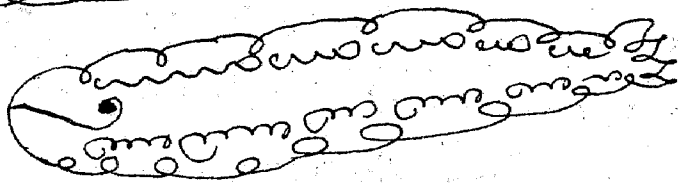
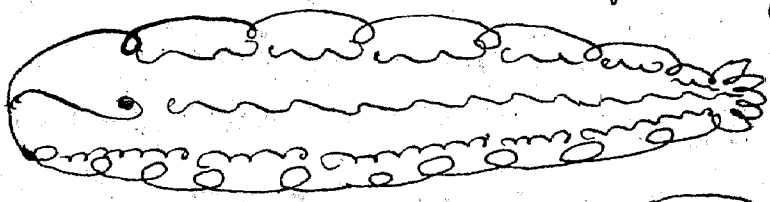

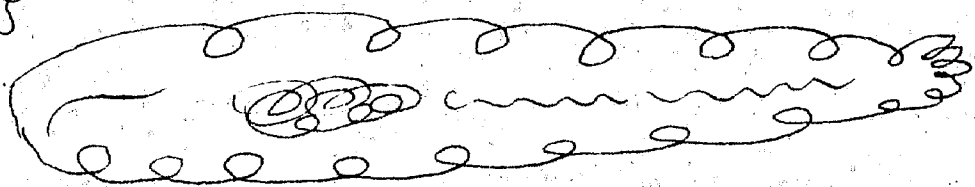
Be it known unto all men by these presents that we Stephen Bage John Bage & William Richardson all inhabitants

full sum of Eighty pounds Sterling money and on y^e payment of y^e same well and truly to be made unto their majesties
or unto any Officer or Officers under them Lawfully Demanding y^e same and y^e to parties before nominated Do you. They
severally and as well firmly really and absolutely bind our selves our heirs Executors and assigns in y^e whole and
for y^e whole as witnesses our hands and seals to y^e Condition of this our obligation Dated this 5th Day of August
in y^e 3rd year of y^e reign of our Sovereign Lord & Lady King William & Queen Mary Anno Domini 1691
The Condition of y^e above obligation is such, that if y^e above bounden Stephen Bage & his Wife Bridget
her son Thomas & her Daughter Susanna Do all of them make their personall appearances at their majesties Court
next to be holden by y^e Justices of Somerset there to answer what shall be Objected agt them by Thomas Oxford
George Russell & Walter Read on y^e Kings behalfs relating to y^e killing stealing and murthering w^{ch} of seven
Barrow hives and two large Biggs or small Shoats, And shall stand and abide Judgmt. of Court upon y^e same
then y^e above obligation to be void utterly void & null, but if otherwise to stand and abide and remain in full
force strength & vertue

Sterling money of England y^e which paymt. well & truly to be made of bind me & my assigns firmly by these
presents to our Sovereign Lord & Lady their heirs & successors without fraud or evasion
The Condition of this obligation is such y^t if y^e above bounden Thomas Oxford shall appear at our next County
Court to be held y^e fourth Tuesday in August next then & there to prosecute & pursue Stephen Bage & Bridget
his wife Thomas Barrow and Susanna his sister and Margaret Kennedy in their majesties behalfs, then this
obligation to be void & of none effect otherwise to be & remains in full force Power & vertue. Given under my
