
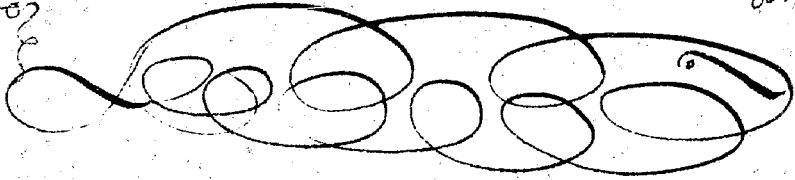


Maryland &c Know all men by these presents that William Byward Comj now Comd Over to the Colony of Virginia for divers good causes and Considerations and therefore not being, have made known and in my stead and place put and Constituted, and by these presents do make known and in my stead and place put and Constitute my loving friends Henry Lyng and Robert Linc of Somerset County Gent: my true and lawfull Attornij and Assignes for me and in my name and to my use, To ask demand Levy recover & receive by all lawfull wayes and means whatsoever and from all and every person or persons whatsoever, whom it dole shall or may concern all and every such sum & sums of money or Tobacco, and all debts, dues duties and demands whatsoever which are owing payable or belonging unto me by Bond Bill account or otherwise, coming and by these presents granting unto my said Attornij all my full power and lawfull authority Concerning the premises, all and every person or persons whom these presents dole or shall concern their and every of their Houses and Ten, Lands and Tenements goods and Chattels if sued, shall be to sue, arrest attach, seize, sequester imprison & imprison, and out of prison to deliver and to appear before all and all manner of Judges and Ministers of the Law, and to compound compromise Controvers agree recover and receive, and of the recoveries and receipts or upon, and Composition or other agreement at quitmises or any other discharges in my name, to make seal and as my deed to deliver, and my Attornij or more under them to make Substitutes and receipt, and generally to do, Execute presents and determine, all and every other act and debt, thing and things whatsoever in or about the premises shall be needfull necessary or convenient, helowey and allowey for firm: and Statute all and whatsoever my said Attornij shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or about the premises, by virtue of these presents.
