The doctherfore give & grant unto you the said George Bossman who enter married with Jane Jones the relict & executrix of the aforesaid m<sup>r</sup> Jones deceased full power & authoritie to administer all & singular the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased & to demand collect and leavy and in legal manner require & receive all & all manner of debts & debts due & owing to the said deceased & well & faithfully to dispose of the same and out of the goods Chattels & Credits of the said deceased which may here or shall come to yo<sup>r</sup> hands or possession well & truly to pay the debts due by the said deceased so far forth as the same will extend and the Law will charge you according to the true value of the summe thereof you having first taken yo<sup>r</sup> oath well & truly to administer y<sup>e</sup> same & be made or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all & singular the goods and Chattels & Credits of the said deceased w<sup>ch</sup> here may or shall come to yo<sup>r</sup> hands possession or knowledge (appraised in money and shew & just amount of and upon yo<sup>r</sup> administration therein & to exhibit both into our County Court which are proved according to power given by certaine ordinaunce of assembly lawfully authorized & charged with Inventory you are presently assigned to performe or at furthest before the second Tuesday in August next ensuing and an account within Twelve months from the date of these presents and lastly we do hereby constitute ordaine & appoint you the said George Bossman administrator of all & singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased signed by ord<sup>r</sup> of Co<sup>rt</sup> this 10<sup>th</sup> day of June in y<sup>e</sup> second year of their Royall Ma<sup>ties</sup> Reigne and in y<sup>e</sup> year of our Lord God one Thousand six hundred & ninety

Know all men by these presents that wee George Bossman Arnold Elzey and John West all of the County of Sommerset and Province of Maryland doe acknowledge & Confess o<sup>r</sup> selves to owe & stand indebted unto their Ma<sup>ties</sup> William & Mary King & Queen of England the just sum of one hundred pounds sterling money of England which wee promise to pay to their Ma<sup>ties</sup> or their Ma<sup>ties</sup> executors and administrators finally by these presents in destination whereof wee have here unto sett our hands & seals this one & twenty day of June in the second year of their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Reigne and in the year of our Lord God one Thousand six hundred and ninety

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound George Bossman doe well & truly observe and satisfy all and every of the will of William Jones deceased w<sup>ch</sup> said will beareth date the thirtieth day of August one Thousand six hundred eighty & nine as well as to pay all & every the debts of the said deceased upon ord<sup>r</sup> had and obtained from their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Justices of the Peace in Co<sup>rt</sup> sitting as also to observe the laws & statutes in the said Co<sup>rt</sup> of administration and to make no waste sale or destruction in or upon the real estate of or plants vine dwelling houses out houses lands woods orchards and fences observing that Law entitled an Act for preservation of or plants real estate and lastly to keepe humble the Justices of the Peace of the said County for probat of wills & granting of administration & all other the officers that then this obligation to be void of none effect otherwise to be & remaine in full power for ever

The condition of the above said obligation is such that if the above bound George Bossman his heirs executors adm<sup>ors</sup>
