Know all men by these presents that we George Bostman a m^r Elzey and John West all of the County of Som^t set and Province of Maryland doe acknowledge & confess o^r selves to owe & beare are indebted unto theire Ma^t William & Mary King & Queen of England the first sum of one hundred pounds sterl^{ing} money of England whiche we promise to pay to them Ma^t or successours all our liens & creditors and administrators friendly by these presents for deft money vnd^r of we haue here unto set our hands & sealed this one & twenty day of June in the second year of their Majesties Reigne and in the year of our Lord God one thousand five hundred and Ninety.

The condition of this obligacion is such that if the above bound George Bostman doe well & duly observe and satisfie all and every of the vnd^r of William Jones deceased in^r said will bearing date the thirteenth day of August one thousand five hundred eighty & nine as well as to pay all & every the debts of the said deceased upon ord^o had and obtained from their Majesties Justices of the Peace in Co^{uncil} setting as also to observe the Plaist & Plaist in the said lett^o of administration and to make no wafer fail or obstructio[n] in or upon the real estate of ex plants w^t dwelling house or out houses lands woods orchards and fentes observing that Lassie enfeoffed in deit for preservation of ex plants real estate and lastly to paye haire to the Justices of the Peace of the said County for probate of wills & granting of administration & all other the officers that then this obligacion to be void & of none effect otherways to be & require in full power force & vertue.
