appointed to receive it the sum of forty pound sterl. to be paid when commanded, by the true & lawful  
of which I doe bind my self my Heirs Exors or Adors. firmly by these presents as in witness hereof  
I have hereunto sett my hand & fixed my seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of March in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of their Majesties  
Reign and y<sup>e</sup> Dow. 1691<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if Margaret Dowry of her good behaviour to all  
their Majesties high People & also pay the four fold of what was ordered by the last Court hold for this County to  
those persons into whom it is due, & likewise to pay off of suit, then this Obligation to be void & of no effect  
or else to stand remain in full force strength & virtue.

hundred acres Brit Coll Howd & two hundred & fifty Long Woods as also three hundred acres at the  
said Tid. lying upon Swanitunt. lying to Nathaniel. Also called Spedwell as also I do freely give  
my & son James all my stock & movables to the value of a penny to him and his Heirs for ever, not  
to be claimed by me or any assign for me, or for me the said James Carter to be firmly indebted  
all the Land & stock to sell give or make up of as he shall think fit, And I John Carter do confirm  
under our hand and seal by and with Consent of Mary my wife, this twenty six<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno Dom. 1692
