

A special Court called by the Sheriff for the County of Somerset in the Counties of Warwick for the Election of Jurors or Delegates for the County the 28. day of April Anno Dom. 1692

Present in Court were: Mr. Francis. Duntind. Mr. Robert. King. Cap. John. Windsor in James. Dast. Mr. W. Gannod. Rouse. Mr. Samuel. Hopkin. Mr. Thomas. Gousb. Cap. John King in James. Layfield.

The Court being called the present being was for the Election of Jurors being signed by the Certificates the Governor as appeared in fo. 205: the freemen qualified proceeded to vote the Major part whereof voted for Mr. John. Hutt. Cap. William. Huntington. Mr. Thomas. Borden & Mr. John. Godwin to be their Jurors or Delegates to serve for this County at the next Generall Assembly to be held at the City of St. Maries the fourth day of May next ensuing the date hereof. Where said Electors did then sign to two Witnesses & seal the same for Confirmation thereof.

Marg the 17. 1692: B. known unto all men by these presents that I Stephen. Page Planter living in the County of Somerset do: here discharge Mardoc. Canaday of all damages that I can always against her, and so I here set my hand Stephen. Page.

At a Called Court the 23. day of May for the purpose of a Certain day for the Election of Jurors or Delegates to serve at this present Generall Assembly. Anno Dom. 1692.

The Court Record that Friday the 27. day of this Instant month is the day appointed for the Election of Jurors or Delegates to serve at this present Generall Assembly now hold at the City of St. Maries. Ordered that the Electors appear at the Court house at ten of the Clock on Friday to give in their votes. Ordered that the Constables give notice to every free holder in their hundred qualified according to list of freemen to appear at aforesaid Order: Ordered that the Sheriff deliver Copies of this Order to the said Constables, and that they forthwith prosecute the Order.

These are to authorize and require that immediately upon receipt hereof you call together four or more Commissioners of the County with the Clerk who are hereby required to sit as a Court & during the time their sitting by virtue of your office to make or cause to be made public proclamation thereby giving notice to all the freemen of the said County who have wife in the said County a stated plantation of fifty Acres of Land at the least or a bilboe & that the value of the same should be valued at the least...
