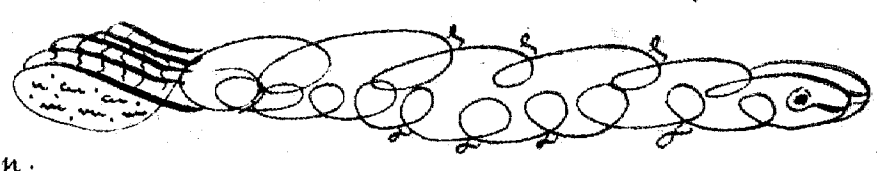


James Nobles: Assign over all my right title & interest of the within written Bill of Sale to the

should not be made void by paying two thousand pounds of tobacco the 10th day of the said  
William. 1691. & the said Bill of Sale should be void between the said Mary Court and the said  
with the said Bill of Sale to be the said Breadstrow as witness my hand this 22 day of January Anno Domini 1691.

Know all men by these presents that we John Taylor Francis Martin & George Nobles of Somerset County in the  
Province of Maryland do acknowledge & confess our selves to owe and are indebted unto Isaac Baker of the said  
County & Province aforesaid the just sum of nine hundred ninety & seven pounds of tobacco good & merchantable  
which we promise to pay to the above named Isaac Baker, or to his Certain Attorney or to his Heirs Executors  
or Assigns to the whole payment well & truly to be done & made: we bind us Ourselves jointly & severally to the  
said Baker & his assigns & his Executors whosoever we have hereunto set our hands & seals this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June  
Anno Domini 1692.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that whereas the above bound John Taylor, by due Course at Law hath  
appeared before our Justices in Court sitting that the above said Isaac Baker, was justly indebted to him & said  
Taylor the just sum of seven hundred forty eight foot of plant & humbly prayed attachment for the same &  
allowance, which by the said Court was granted upon the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1689: & in June 1691: the said Attachment  
issued against the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Baker for nine hundred ninety seven foot of plant which  
said sum was attached by the sheriff of our said County, and made due return thereof before our Justices in Court  
sitting 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 1691: and the said Taylor then prayed execution might issue thereon which by the said Court  
was granted the said Taylor giving security according to Law. which Condition is such that if the said above bound  
Isaac Baker, shall within one year & a day to be computed from the day of the said attachment awarded come  
in person or by his lawfull Attorney appear to the said Original action against the said John Taylor, and make appear  
that the said plt. hath been and is satisfied of his debt or demands in the said action, or shall otherwise in Court demand  
or take the 10 p<sup>ts</sup>. of the same, & that the plt. make restitution according to Law, that then this Obligation to be void  
and of none effect. Otherwise to be & remain in full power force & virtue.
