 proceed not in any of the said aforesaid to take land or members. And that in every such case you shall if any person
 write now your name and his words matter depending with you is not kept a secret but to be known for
 this our Province whatsoever or whatsoever to be taken there to be tried and further not as aforesaid by
 to issue out writs, precepts and attachments to the plea of Eyre and Criminer, and also judgments
 to award in all causes civil whether in actions real or personall according to the laws, orders & reasonable customs
 and used in this our Province of Maryland in writing causes civil to be tried. Excepting as before excepted.
 Do: Councillors read and appoint you in Francis. Gombins. Cap. John. Winder. in James. Pastrol and in
 Doctor to be Judges as aforesaid and therefore we do command, that you diligently attend the keeping of the
 Laws and Orders, and all and singular other the premises and at certain dayes appointed according to the
 in that case provided and such places where you or any four or more of you as aforesaid shall in that behalf appoint
 Enquiry upon the premises performed fulfill the same in forme aforesaid. Doing therein that which is justis appor-
 -tune according to the Laws Orders & reasonable Customs of this our Province. Saving to us the utmost revenue
 and other things herof to us belonging. And therefore we command the sheriffs of the said County of ~~St. Marys~~
 to be of these precepts that at the dayes and places aforesaid where you or any four or more of you as aforesaid
 shall make known to him to give his attendance on you and if need require, to cause to come before you or any four
 or more of you as aforesaid such & so many good & lawfull men of the County by whom the truth of the
 premises may the better be known & Enquired of. And lastly we have appointed John. ~~St. John~~ Clerk &
 keeper of the Records & proceedings in this Court and therefore you shall cause to be brought before you at the
 said dayes & places the writs, precepts, process & indictments to the Court & Jurisdiction belonging that if same
 may be inspected & by a due course examined as aforesaid. Given at our City of St. Maries the 11. of April in the
 fourth year of our reign, and in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred ninety two. Witness our Trusty

 you are not to fail, and when you have so done, you are to certify the same, under your hands & seals to us in our high Court of
 Chancery with all convenient speed. Witness our Trusty & well beloved Lieut. Copley Esq. Our Cap. Generall & Governour
 in Chief in & over our Province & Territory of Maryland aforesaid the eleventh day of April in the fourth year of our
 reign &c. Anno Domini 1692.
