To all Christian People to whom these presents shall come, I Philip: Hammond of the County of Somerset and  
 Brebim above said send greeting in our Lord God everlasting. Know ye that I the said Philip: Hammond for  
 in Consideration of two thousand two hundred pounds of le Bane, what I the said Philip do justly owe  
 to Lawrence Crawford of the County of Brebim above said also in Consideration that the  
 said Lawrence hath consented & agreed to keep & maintain me the said Philip in sickness & in health, with  
 sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing & lodging during the time of my naturall life, or so long as the said  
 Philip shall be willing to require the same only living at the said Lawrence Crawford's Plantation where the  
 said Crawford shall live himself, as also for other good causes & valuable Considerations me therein  
 especially moving, have given, granted, & by these presents do freely & fully & absolutely give, grant and  
 confirm unto the said Lawrence Crawford, all and singular such goods, Chattels, Movable & Imovable  
 as are now in my Custody & possession properly appertaining & belonging unto me, or in the Custody and  
 possession of any other person whatsoever, with all & singular my lands & Tenements & Hereditaments  
 specified in a certain Patent under the great Seal of the said Brebim of Maryland bearing date the third day  
 of July. Ann. Dom. 1681. Containing five hundred acres of Land, lying on the South Side of Potomack River  
 known by the Name of Gorgey as more fully appears by the said Patent To have & to hold the said  
 goods Chattels Lands & Tenements, with all & singular the above said premises, unto the said Lawrence Crawford  
 his Heirs & Assigns to him & their own proper use & Benefit for ever, freely quietly & peaceably  
 out any manner of Claim, Challenge or Demand of me the said Philip: Hammond or of any other person or  
 persons whatsoever, for me, in my name, by my cause means or procurement, & without any money or other  
 thing therefore to be paid or done but that is above specified, to me the said Philip my Heirs & Assigns  
 And the said Philip: Hammond, all and singular the aforesaid goods, Chattels Lands & Tenements, with  
 above said premises to the said Lawrence Crawford his Heirs & Assigns all people do warrant & for ever  
 by these presents. And further I the said Philip: Hammond, have put the said Lawrence Crawford, in peaceable  
 possession of all & singular the above said premises by delivery of the Patent & other the Rights of the said  
 of Land called Gorgey in name & behalf of all my goods Chattels Lands & Tenements, at my  
 delivery of these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal  
 the fourth day of March Anno Dom. 1692.
