County & Province of Maryland of the one Part And George Crutit of the County & Province aforesaid Part of the
other Part Witnesseth that whereas the R^r hon^rble s^d Lord Lopp aforesaid by his deed of grant under y^e gracie
seale used in the said Province aforesaid for granting of Land there bearing date at y^e City of s^d Mar^r y^e Twenty four
day of october in the eight year of his Lopp^r Dominion one thousand Sipplund Seaventy & Nine for the Consideration
herein herein mentioned did grant unto William Stevens of Sommersett County & Province aforesaid gentl all that
particular tract or deuident of land called Mulberry grove Now this Indenture further witnesseth that the said
Elizabeth Stevens for and in Consideration of the summe of one & twenty Chouard pounds of Cobage to her in hand

lying and being on the east side of Cheape peake bay on the South side of Potomac river bounded ab^r Hollowell
