This Indenture made the Twentieth Third day of April in the Second year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary over England &c. And in the year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred and ninety Between Thomas Miller of Sommersett County in the Province of Maryland ~~and~~ Sarah his wife of the one Part and George Fairfax of the 3^d County of Sommersett and Province of Maryland Esq^r of the other Part Witnesseth That whereas the Lord Baltimore by his Deed of grant under the great seal used in the Province of Maryland for granting of Lands there bearing date at y^e City of St. Maryes in the aforesaid Province of Maryland the one and Twentieth day of November in the Sixth year of his Lordships Dominion over the said Province of Maryland Annoq^o Do^m one thousand six hundred eighty and one did for the Consideration therein mentioned grant unto John Anderson of the aforesaid County and Province of Maryland all that parcel of Land called Hogg Quarter situated lying & being on the South Side of Potomack river in Sommersett County containing Thirteen hundred and fifty acres more or less To have and to hold the same to him the said John Anderson his heirs and assigns for ever under such covenants conditions & limitations as in and by the said Deed of grant (recourse being thereunto had) more fully and more at large it may & doth appear And since vizt: on the sixteenth day of December in the seventh year of his said Lordships Dominion one thousand six hundred eighty and one the said John Anderson by his certain Deed of Indenture duly executed and enrolled in the said County of Som:sett the 14th day of Jan: Annoq^o Do^m 1682 did make over unto the above named Coll^o William Stevens the above said Thirteen hundred & fifty acres of Land called Hogg quarter To have and to hold the same to him the said William Stevens and to his heirs and assigns for ever And since vizt: on the seventeenth day of August in the Eight year of the Dominion of the R^o hon^{ble} Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. and in the year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred eighty and three the said Coll^o William Stevens and Elizabeth his wife by their certain Deed of Indenture duly executed & enrolled in the 3^d County of Som:sett the sixteenth day of October Annoq^o Do^m 1683 for the Consideration therein mentioned did grant bargain sell & offer and confirm unto the above named Thomas Miller and to his heirs and assigns for ever a part of the above said parcel of Land called Hogg quarter to the quantity of seven hundred and fifty acres bounded as followeth beginning at a great marked pine standing by a branch barrow in the woods near a little swamp and running from the said pine South east half a point southerly one hundred & five perches to a white oak standing near a white marsh and from the said oak with a line drawn South west two hundred and sixty perches to a white oak standing in a branch being the head of Haulstone Creek And from the said oak by a line drawn North west half a point North west one hundred ninety five perches to a white oak And from the said oak west & by North twenty eight perches to a stooping white oak and from y^e oak North west half a point North west with y^e course until it runs to the divisionall line between Conventure and Hogg quarter and from the end of the aforesaid line by a right line to the first corner the great line by a branch side as aforesaid containing seven hundred and fifty acres more or less and is now called Millers Lot Together with all its rights Privileges & Benefits thereunto belonging on those conditions as by the said Indenture (recourse being thereunto had) more fully & more at large it may & doth appear Now this Indenture further witnesseth That the above named
