

Chrs Jndenturē made the Twenty fourth day of January in the xviijth year of the Dominion of the R^e
 hon^rble Charles absolute Lord & Prop^r of the Provinces of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &
 in the year of our Lord God 1660 Betwenee Donn^rk Dennis of Sommersett County in the Province of
 Maryland plante & Ellis his wife of the one part And John Weston of the County of Somersett & Province of
 Maryland Lawyer of the other part witnesseth that whereas the R^e hon^rble Cecilius Lord Baron of
 Baltimore deceased by his Deed of grant unde the great seal used in the said Province for Granting of
 Lands bearing date at St. Maries the 23rd day of September in the xxviith year of his R^e hon^rble Lordship Dominion or
 Anno Domini 1665 did for the consideration therin mentioned grant unto German Gillett al^y parcell
 of Land called Ware Point lying on the eastern shore by river there called Potomack on the western side of
 Mertanic Creek called Morunstro Creek beginning at a marked oak standing east of the eastern point of
 Marsh adjoining to the said Creek & running along by the said marsh a line drawn south fifty perches
 for breadth to a marked pine standing south thence running a line west to a marked oak three hundred and
 twenty perches for length and so running North by a line drawn from the end of the west line fifty
 perches to a marked pine thence running east by a line drawn from the aforesaid Linethree hundred
 & twenty perches containing & now laid out for one hundred and more or less together with all rights
 Proffitts & Benifits thereunto belonging (royall mire excepted) to have & to hold the same to him the said German
 Gillett his heires and assignes for ever videlicet & Conditions therin mentioned recoure unto the said
 Tenant being had it doth & may more fully & at large appear and whereas the said German Gillett & Sarah
 his wife did by a deed writing under their hands & seals bearing date the 26th day of March in the
 year of our Lord God 1667 for a valuable consideration by them recd grants allientate bargaine sold and
 confirmed unto the aforesaid Donn^rk Dennis his heires and assignes all & singular the above mentioned
 premises with all rights proffitts & benifits thereunto belonging as in & by the said recited deed containing
 more fully and at large recoure thereto being had it doth & may appear And further whereas the R^e
 hon^rble Lord Baron of Baltimore by his Deed of grant videlicet the great seal used in the S^t Province for granting
 of Lands there bearing date at the City of St. Maries y^e eighth day of May in the fourteynth year of his R^e hon^rble dominion
 or Anno Domini 1679 did for the consideration therin mentioned grant unto the aforesaid Donn^rk Dennis
 al^y Parcell of Land called Bebbey lying on the east side of Bebbey Bay on the North side of Potomack Bay
 in a creek of the said bay called Morunstro bounded as followeth Beginning at a marked small white oak
 standing on the North side of a small hummock of woods on the westernmost side of the said Creek thence with
 a line drawn east South east fifty perches thence with a line drawn South east forty five perches to a small
 Creek in Marishie thence with a line drawn North east eighteen perches thence with a line drawn east
 South east one hundred and eighty eight perches in Marishie thence with a line drawn North North East
 one hundred twenty six perches thence with a line drawn West two hundred & fiftith perches to a great
 Pine stump on a point of land and from thence with a line drawn to the first bounday containing one hundred
 & fifty acres (more or less) together with all rights Proffitts & Benifits thereunto belonging Aquitainie excepted
 To have & to hold the same unto him the said Donn^rk Dennis his heires and assignes for ever videlicet such
 & as service & conditions as by the said recited Deed recoure being thereto had more fully and at
 large it doth and may appear how this Jndenture futher witnesseth after the aforesaid Donn^rk Dennis
 & Ellis his wife for divers good causes & considerations as well as for the Consideration of divers thousand
 pounds of tobacco & asse to them in hand paid by the aforesaid John Weston before his departing and
 delivery hereof sufficient and wherewith the said Donn^rk Dennis & Ellis his wife doth fully discharge themselves
 fully satisfied & paid & thence & every part & parcell thereof doth freely & absolutely dischage the said John Weston
 his heires and assignes for ever And by this presents have given granted bargained and sold & do by this
 presents give grant allientate enforfeite bargaine & sell unto the said John Weston his heires and
 assignes for ever all the in two parcels of Land aforesaid called Ware point & Bebbey together with
 all & singular his & Proffitts Priviledges Patisnes writings (modis & p[ri]m dments) withall
 and singular the houses Edifices or lands gardens serues appurtenances Enoluments & easements
