

Therein mentioned & so granted unto the said John Emmitt a certaine tract of Land called the enlargement tract
 lying & being on the east side of Chichester Bay and on the south east side of Promontory river about one mile & halfe
 of the river beginning at a stone boundary belonging to Amulbury grove from thence North thirty degrees west one
 hundred perches to a marked white oak thence east thirty degrees North Sixty perches to another white oak marked
 thence South thirty eight degrees east one hundred Sixty perches to a marked white oak thence South thirty
 four degrees west three hundred & eighty perches thence North fifty four degrees one hundred and four perches
 binding upon George Emmitts land to another white oak marked thence North Sixty six degrees east binding upon hillier
 grove to the first boundary containing & layd out for three hundred acres more or less according to Certificate of the
 Survey thereof taken & returned into the Land office at the City of St. Marys bearing date the Eighteenth day of
 September anno 1604 & there remaining upon record for three hundred acres as aforesaid together with
 all rights profits benefits & Priviledges thereto belonging to all times excepted to have & to hold the said
 tract of Land to him the said John Emmitt his heirs & assigns for ever unto the rents and services in the said
 grant reserved wherein he is vested more fully & more at large it may & doth appear by this Indenture
 further witnesseth that the said John Emmitt and Hannah his wife for divers good causes & considerations then
 there unto moving but more especially for & in consideration of Leaven thousand pounds of Cobano unto
 them in hand paid by the said John Hillier before sealing & delivering hereof the receipt whereof & of every part
 and parcel thereof the said John Emmitt & Hannah his wife both hereby acknowledge and thereof doth fully
 freely clearly & absolutely warrant & generalize & discharge the said John Hillier his heirs & assigns & administrators
 for ever by virtue of this Indenture have given granted bargained & sold enfeoffed & confirmed and by these
 presents doth give grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto him the said John Hillier his heirs & assigns
 for ever all that tract of Land before mentioned called the enlargement tract and bounded as aforesaid
 together with all the rights profits benefits & appurtenances thereto belonging Royal manors excepted
 to have and to hold the same & every part & parcel thereof to him the said John Hillier & to him only
 proper use & behoofe of the said John Hillier his heirs & assigns administrators & assigns for ever without any mortgage
 condition redemption use or limitation to recall after charge or determine the same the rents & services due to the
 Lord or Lords of the fee alwaies excepted & foreprized Hid the said John Emmitt and Hannah his wife for themselves
 their heirs & executors administrators & assigns do covenant promise & grant to and with the said John Hillier
 his heirs & assigns & to & with every of them by these presents in manner & forme following that
 to say that the said John Emmitt and Hannah his wife now are & both of them are and standeth lawfully &
 possessed and interested of and in the said tract of Land called the enlargement with all rights & singularly in
 appurtenances thereto Hid that they the said John Emmitt & Hannah his wife have good right full power & lawfull
 chyfdom to give grant bargain aliene sell convey enfeoff & confirm the said Land
 & premises with the and every of the appurtenances unto him the said John Hillier his heirs & assigns administrators
 & assigns in manner and forme as aforesaid and that he the said John Hillier his heirs & executors administrators & assigns
 shall & lawfullie may from time to time and at all times for ever hereafter stand amply & perfectly lawfully
 and effectually seized and possessed of and in the premises and the appurtenances and shall lawfullie payably and
 quietly have hold occupie possesse the Land aforesaid called enlargement together with all rights and singularly the
 commodities hereditaments and appurtenances thereto in any way appertaining without the lawfull let & detaine
 trouble interruptiou or disturbance of any person or persons whatsoever and also free & clear & freely &
 clearly acquited & purerated & discharged or otherwise sufficiently & well saved & kept harmless of and
 from all and all manner of former & oþer bargaines sales gifts grants leases estates rights & cyles
 joynures tenures franchises mortgages statutis recognizances judgments executors rents &
 annuitis charges buttments instruments whatsoever had made done or suffered or to be had made or
 done or suffered by the said John Emmitt or Hannah his wife or either of them either in either of their lives
 executors administrators or assignees of any other person or persons whatsoever did or that they the said John
 Emmitt or Hannah his wife or the said executors administrators or assignees of either of them shall & will
 from time to time and at all times hereafter at the reasonable request & at the amþy cost & charge make
 law of the said John Hillier his heirs & executors administrators or assignees make or procure
 & suffer or cause to be made done attested & sealed a þerute & suffered all & every sum further & other debts
 thing & things devise & devised insurances & assurances in the said instrument for the further & more effect
