This Indenture made the tenth day of June in the year of our Lord God: according to the computation of the Church of England, one thousand six hundred & three<sup>d</sup> Between John Frizzell of Princeton in the County of Sommerset & Province of Maryland planter and Cullett his wife on the one part and William Ballis at the Head of Potowomotie River in the County aforesaid planter on the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Frizzell & Cullett his wife for and in consideration of the sum<sup>r</sup> of eleven thousand pounds of good tobacco and Cattle to them in hand paid at or before the ensingal<sup>r</sup> & delivery hereof the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge. Of which part & parcel hereof acquit & discharge him the said William Ballis And doo
