

Credits belonging or appertaining to Joseph Freeman late of this County to answer unto the S^r Francis Jenkins in a plea of debt to the value of eight thousand six hundred sixty four pounds of tobacco at least returne thereof being made too Justice the 10th day of June last past for eight thousand six hundred sixty and five pounds of tobacco attayed by the Sheriff at the returne in schedule ingrossed make app^r The said Francis Jenkins having made appare his originall debt Justly due before o^r Justice in sitting the 13th day of the said month of June & the vizt the 13th day of June 1690 the Justice of o^r S^r County sitting the said debt attayed & condemned the same by way of execution to be delivered to the said Francis Jenkins

Now the Condition of the above^d obligation is such that if in case the said absent defend^r Joseph Freeman shall one year and aday (to be ~~forwa^rd~~ accounted from the day of the said attayment awarded) come either in person or by his Lawfull attorney appare in the said originall action against the S^r Francis Jenkins & make appare that the said plaintiff hath beene & is satisfied of his debt or in his said action or shall otherwise discontinue or bar the S^r plaintiff of the same that the plaintiff make restitution according to lawe: as also to save & keepe harmless their Ma^{ties} Justice of the Peace for the S^r County of Somers^{et} and all other the officers that then this obligation to stand void & of effect otherwise to be and remaine in full force power and vertue /
