 in freehold in the said Land Hid since vj^t on the first day of February in the eleventh year
 of the Dominion of the aforesaid R^t Ronib^b Charkis grover Maryland anno d^r 1676 the aforesaid
 William Manloue & Alice his wife by thire certane Deed of Indenture made experid^d
 & enrolled I do grant Bargaine & sell unto the above mentioned Thomas Lydder part of
 aforesaided partell of Land called Morris hope bounded as followeth beginning at a
 dead white oak being a corner tree of a partell of land surveyed for the R^t R^b Col^r
 William Stevens on the side of Potomack Bay thence with a line drawn North north east
 one hundred threescore five feet to a white thorn with a line drawn South west one hundred eighty
 leaven perches to a marked white oak on the Bay side & front thence with a line drawn

 R^t Ronib^b Charkis Lord Baltimore by his Deed of grant vnd^r y^e great seal usd in y^e Province
 of Maryland for granting of lands there bearing date at y^e City of S^t Maries the 16 day
 of June in y^e fourt^h year of his said Lordships Dominion over Maryland anno d^r 1679
 I do for the Consideration herein mentioned graunt unto the said William Manloue his heires
 & assignes adrat for partell of Land called & knowne by the name of Preston at the Common
 Point Sticke living and beeing on the eastr^t side of Piscataway Bay on the heastr^t side
 of Potomack Bay in Somersett County aforesaid bounded as followeth beginning at a marked
 red oak standing in the line of marked trees of a partell of land formerly surveyed for the aforesaid
 mentioned Maurice Lister thence with a line drawn South west two hundred & fiftth perches
 to a marked white oak being a corner tree of a partell of land surveyed for the said Lister
 thence with a line drawn South west eighty perches to a small fresh water Run called
 y^e Moyle of the said Run from thence with a line drawn to y^e first bound^r cont^d fifty acre more
 or less to have & to hold the same to him the said William Manloue his heires & assignes
 for ever by w^t & said fiftth acre together with y^e forty four acres last mentioned being part of
 Morris hope as also y^e last perched fiftth acre called y^e Preston alias Common point in all
 Ninety four acres of land (now called by the name of the Epiphany) together with all and

 timber or timber like trees & all & singular the working tools chalders conveyances
