acknowledge & confesse our selves to owe & are indebted unto their Ma<sup>ties</sup>  
William & Mary King & Queene over England for the just sum of Two  
hundred poinds sterling money of England And for the true performann  
of the same to be well & truly paid wee bind us and each of us our heires  
executors & ad<sup>ors</sup> to their Ma<sup>ties</sup> their heires or successors finally by these  
presents in Testimony whereof wee haue hereunto set our hand & seals  
the fourth day of February in the second year of their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Reigne and

The condition of the abovesaid Obligation is such that if the abovesaid Mary noble  
doe well & truly observe and satisfie all & every the will of Isaac noble deceased w<sup>th</sup> will  
bearing date the fiftenth day of September one Thousand six hundred eighty and three which  
to pay all & every the debts of the said deceased upon ord<sup>ers</sup> had and obtained from her Ma<sup>ties</sup>  
Justices of the Peace in Court sitting as also to observe the Clause & Clauses in the said Lett<sup>ers</sup>  
of administration and to make nos waste sale or destruction in off or upon the Reall estate  
of orphans vizt dwelling houses out houses lanes woods orchards and fences observing  
that Law entituled an Act for preservation of orphans reall estates And lastly to  
keepe harmless & indemnifyed the Justices of the Peace of the s<sup>d</sup> County in Probate of  
Wills & granting of administrations and all other the officers therein concerned that  
then this obligation to be void & of none effect otherwise to be & remaine in full power  
force & virtue

This Indenture made the sixth day of October in the xij<sup>th</sup> year of y<sup>e</sup> Dominion of the R<sup>ty</sup>  
hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles Lord Prop<sup>er</sup> of the Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore  
& in the year of our Lord God one Thousand six hundred eighty and eight Between  
Lawrence Cransford late of Northampton County in Virginia M<sup>er</sup> of the one part  
And Sarah White of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland widow whole &  
sole executrix of y<sup>e</sup> last will & Testament of John White late of the s<sup>d</sup> County of Som<sup>er</sup>  
of the other part Witnesseth that whereas Cecilus of noble memory over  
y<sup>e</sup> Province of Maryland & Avalon or by his Deed of grant und<sup>er</sup> und<sup>er</sup> y<sup>e</sup> great seals  
used in the said Province of Maryland for granting of Lands there bearing date at the  
City of St<sup>ts</sup> Maries the four & twentieth day of February in the four & thirtieth y<sup>e</sup>  
of the Dominion of his s<sup>d</sup> Lopp<sup>er</sup> y<sup>e</sup> R<sup>ty</sup> hon<sup>ble</sup> Cecilus over Maryland or Annoq<sup>ue</sup> Do<sup>mine</sup> 1665  
for y<sup>e</sup> consideration therein mentioned grant to William Stevens of the County of Som<sup>er</sup> s<sup>d</sup>  
Province of Maryland gent<sup>l</sup> all that tract of Land called Partners Choice situate lying & be  
in y<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> County of Som<sup>er</sup> s<sup>d</sup> lying & being on the eastern shore on the North side of Potomac  
river bounded as followeth beginning at a marked red oak standing by a parcel of Land  
taken up by Thomas White & running from the s<sup>d</sup> oak North east by a marsh called  
Partners Marsh six hundred Perches to a marked white oak standing near unto y<sup>e</sup>  
of the afores<sup>d</sup> river for breadth thence with a line drawn North west unto the woods  
to a marked white oak standing thence with a line drawn
