 manner & forme following that is to say first & principally I commend my soul to almighty  
 god my Creator assured believing y<sup>e</sup> I shall receive full pardon and free remission of all  
 my sins and be saved by the precious death & merits of my blessed saviour & redeemer Christ Jesu  
 and my body to the earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such convenient place  
 as I thinke fitt and touching such worldly estate as the Lord in merry hath sent me my  
 will & meaning is that y<sup>e</sup> same shall be imployed and bestowed as hereafter by this my  
 will expressed and first doe revoke renounce frustrate and make void all wills by me formerly  
 made: And declare and appoint this my last will and Testament. Item doe ord<sup>r</sup> and ordaine  
 that all parcell of Land y<sup>e</sup> goe by the name of Priests vineyard and another parcell of land  
 called the Agreement shall be equally divided between my loving Daughters Margaret  
 Price and Ann Price Item doe ord<sup>r</sup> y<sup>e</sup> as for Plantation and housing they shall have equall  
 share while they are better provided. Item I leave adharsh called Mistle Meadow containing  
 three hundred acres for my loving Daughters Margaret & Ann and they to have equall  
 shares of the same for range. Item doe ord<sup>r</sup> and ordaine that if either of Margaret  
 and Ann should die without issue y<sup>e</sup> all the above<sup>d</sup> land and Marsh to returne to my  
 Cousin James Price and his wife Mary Price the plantation housing  
 and Land and Cattle Mare and their increase and hoggs household stuffe and goods that James  
 possid<sup>d</sup> with as long as she continues a widowe but if she does marry to have but her  
 share and the rest of all household goods stuffe and goods and Cattle and hoggs and Mare  
 and horse to be equally divided betweene Margaret Price & Ann Price Item I leave  
 my well beloved wife Mary Price to doe with them as she thinke convenient as witness  
 my hand and seale this 2<sup>d</sup> day of September 1600

 & Ireland King & Queene defenders of the Faith or Do Mary Price of Sommerset County greeting  
 Wher as James Price of the said County deceased doe therefore give & grant unto you the  
 said Mary Price full power & authority to administrate all and singular the goods Chattels and  
 Credits of the said deceased and to demand collect and receive and in Legall manner  
 require & receive all and all manner of debt & debts due & owing to y<sup>e</sup> said deceased  
 and well & faithfully to dispose of the same and out of the goods Chattels of the said deceased which  
 have may or shall come to yo<sup>r</sup> hands or possession well & truly to pay the debts due by the said  
 deceased so far forth as the same will thereunto extend and the Law will charge you according  
 to the true value of the summe thereof; you having first taken yo<sup>r</sup> oath well & truly to ad-  
 ministrare the same and to make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all and  
 singular y<sup>e</sup> goods & Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have may or shall come to  
 yo<sup>r</sup> hands possession or knowledge (appraised in money) and a true and just amount of and upon y<sup>e</sup>  
 administration therein and to exhibit both into o<sup>r</sup> County Court where wills are proved according  
 to power given by a certain ordinance made the last assembly lawfully authorized touching  
 which Inventory you are presently assigned to performe or at furthest at or before the first  
 Tuesday in June next ensuing and an amount within twelve months from the date of the  
 presents and lastly wee doe hereby constitute ordain and appoint you the said Mary Price  
 administratrix of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased Signe  
 by ord<sup>r</sup> of Court this twentieth day of March in y<sup>e</sup> first year of their Royall Ma<sup>ties</sup> Raigne  
 over England the first year of our Lord God one Thousand six hundred eighty and nine
