 Beazely living with my cousin Thomas expord of the s^d County did then freely fully & really & absolutely give & bestow
 of to my said Kinswoman one Cow with calf together with all her increase for ever except every other bull calf until my
 Kinswoman shall marry or attaine the age of one & twenty years to have & to hold the s^d Cow with calf together with her
 ab afore said And where as the s^d Cow with calf hath produced only two heifers which are now living of all the stock from
 the s^d calf given & bestowed ab afore said and for want of heirs no Deed of gift made of the s^d Donation know all ye
 whom this presents shall or may come that I the said Sarah Saunders doe by virtue hereof now more amply & fully
 Corroborate & confirm the said Donation with the consent & approbation of my husband John Saunders videlicet
 hands & seals of the s^d two heifers aboves^d the one two year old the other a yearling being marked by cropping
 under sitting both ears To have and to hold the said heifers with their Increase ab abovesaid to the s^d Mary
 & her heirs for ever without any exception or reservation only the bull Calves for the time afore said & for
 further Confirmation of the s^d gift's Deed with mine & my husband's Love and affection unto the s^d Mary
