This Indenture made the first day of May in the second year of their ma<sup>ty</sup> Raigne William & Mary by the grace of god King & Queene of Brittain and in the year of our Lord god one thousand six hundred & ninety Betweene Capt<sup>e</sup> Henry Smith of the County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland of the one Party And John Goldsmith Jun<sup>r</sup> of the County & Province aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the R<sup>ty</sup> hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c by his Deed of grant vnder y<sup>e</sup> great seal used in y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Province of Maryland for granting of Land there bearing date the tenth day of August in the thirthe year of his dominion Anno<sup>m</sup> Do<sup>m</sup> 1684 did for the consideration therein mentioned grant unto the said Capt<sup>e</sup> Henry Smith all y<sup>e</sup> parcel or tract of Land called Shickster situated lying & being on the east side of Chesapeake bay on the south side of the head of Annapolis river back in the woods from the water side bounded as by Patent will appear and containing Nine hundred and more or less Together with all rights Profitts & Benefitts there unto belonging (royall mine be excepted) to hold to him y<sup>e</sup> said Capt<sup>e</sup> Henry Smith his heirs & assigns forever under such covenants Limitations & exceptions as in & by the said Deed of grant remaining upon record in the secretaries office record being thereunto had more fully and at large it may & dothe appear. Now this Indenture further Witnesseth that the above named Capt<sup>e</sup> Henry Smith for and in consideration of Eight thousand pounds of tobacco to him in hand paid by the within named John Goldsmith before the delivery hereof whereof and where with the said Capt<sup>e</sup> Henry Smith dothe acknowledge himselfe fully satisfied & delivered of and for every part & parcel thereof acquit & discharged the s<sup>r</sup> John Goldsmith his heirs & assigns & administrators by these presents hath given granted bargained sold feoffed & confirmed & doeth by these presents fully freely and absolutely give grant alienate bargain sell feoff & confirmed unto the s<sup>r</sup> John Goldsmith his heirs or assigns for ever one hundred acres called Goldsmiths delight out of y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid tract called Shickster, bounded as followeth beginning at a marked white oak standing upon the south side of Smiths branch downe in a point being the first boulder of the above said tract called Shickster, thence running southeast one hundred & eight perches to a marked white oak thence running north fifty degrees east two hundred & eighty perches thence running north west thirty five perches to the aforesaid branch thence running downe the s<sup>r</sup> branch to the first boulder containing & now laid out for one hundred and some more or less according with the said Deed of grant with all & singular y<sup>e</sup> houses buildings &c
