 so made with my last will and Testament as followeth my love friend to wit that save it touching the salvation here
 the memory of my soul and merits of my redemption Jesus Christ my soul to mitt to the party to be lawfully bound as
 my Executor's or their names shall find fault and for what worldly and outward estate it hath peradventure I do to
 bless me with all I give and bequeath as followeth my just debts being first paid, I give and bequeath to Elizabeth
 Keyser my Brother to his Sonne or to his daughter the third part of what my father George Keyser hath left me
 his last will and Testament I give and bequeath to my Brother John Keyser, Sonne or to his daughter the third part
 of what my father George Keyser hath left me in his last will and Testament. I give and bequeath to my Sister Mary
 would her Sonne or to his daughter the third part of what my father George Keyser hath left me in his last will and Testament
 to have her Heire and Assignes for ever, I give and bequeath to Hans Cooper, one Cow, the future male increase to her
 selfe and female to her two daughters after her delivery. I give and bequeath to William Strillite one Cow with
 all the future increase after delivery. I give and bequeath to Martha Gregory one two year old Heifer and all the future
 increase after delivery. I give and bequeath to Lawrence Crawford the three hundred acres of Land left to me in Colonel Hobbes
 will to him to him his Heire or Assignes for ever. I give and bequeath to Mr. George Layfield one thousand pounds of
 tobacco of the two thousand Colonell Hobbes left me provided that the said Crawford have peradventure possession of the three hundred
 acres above specified. I give and bequeath to Mr. George Layfield the hundred acres of Land called Holly head.
 provided that he pay to the said Crawford the other thousand pounds of tobacco, and put him in peradventure possession
 of Merrimack three hundred acres his Heire or Assignes for ever. And if Mr. George Layfield will neither give
 Merrimack nor the tobacco I bequeath to Crawford Holly head to him his Heire or Assignes for ever. I give and
 bequeath to my Cousin William White, one black stags telt, with silver buttons. I give and bequeath to my Cousin
 Tabitha White, Grisilla White, Sarah White, each of them one yearling Heifer for the price, or one yearling
 Bull the price as it falls out with my tithel and all the future increase after delivery. I give and bequeath
 to my Cousin Stobond White one yearling Heifer and all her increase after delivery. I give and bequeath
 to my Cousin Stobond White one yearling horse or one yearling mare with all her future increase after delivery.
 I give and bequeath to my Cousin William White the bed and all belong to it after delivery. I give and
 bequeath my bay horse called Robbin to Mr. Lawrence Crawford his Heire or Assignes when found, and also I do
 ordaine and nominate, constitute and appoint Lawrence Crawford and John Timmott to be my whole and sole Executors
 after my last will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all other former will or wills by me made
 done. In witness whereof I have hereunto sett and affixed my hand and seal the twenty six day of March
 Anno Domini 1691.
