Know all men by these presents that wee Mary Price administratrix of James Price deceased Gentleman Ward and John Roark all of the County of Somersett and Province of Maryland doe acknowledge & confess our selves to owe and are indebted unto their Majesty William & Mary King & Queen of England the first Summe of one hundred pounds of Sterling money of England w^{ch} wee promise to pay to their Majesty and for the performance of y^e same to be well & truly paid wee binde us and our heirs executors and adm^{rs} in y^e percell Summe of Two hundred pounds of like money in Testimony whereof wee have hereunto set our hands & seals this seventeenth day of April in y^e first year of their Majesty's reign Annoq. Do^m 1690

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Mary Price doe well & truly observe and satisfie all & every of the will of James Price deceased bearing date y^e second day of September Annoq. Do^m 1689 as well as to pay all & every the debts of the said deceased upon o^r had and obtained from their Majesty Justices of y^e Peace in Court sitting abovesaid to observe the Peace & Quiet in the 3^d Letters of administration and to make no waste sale or destruction in or upon the real estate of orphans viz dwelling houses and houses Lands woods or tiards & fences otherwise by Law inhibited an act for preservation of orphans real estate that then this obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to be & remaine in full power force & virtue
