William and Mary by the Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King and Queen do hereby
the said Sr. Lawrence Crawford of Somerset County greeting, whereas Benjamin Heizer of the
County do hereby did by his last will and testament appoint you the said Lawrence Crawford and John Emmott
his Executors but the said Emmott having in Open Court relinquished his Executorship, we do therefore grant
unto you the said Lawrence Crawford full power and authority to administer all and singular the goods chattels
and credits of the said deceased, and to demand collect and levy and in legal manner require and receive all
in manner of debt and debts due and owing to the said deceased and well and faithfully to dispose of the same
and out of the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased, which here may or shall come to your hands or possession
well and truly to pay the debts due by the said deceased, so far forth as the same will extend and the law will charge
you according to the true value of the same thereof, you having first taken your Oath well and truly to do the
same, and to make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits
of the said deceased, which here may or shall come to your hands or possession or know ledge (appraised in money) and
a true and just account of and upon your Administration therein, and to exhibit both into our County Court where
wills are proved, according to power given by a British Ordinance of Assembly lawfully authorized. Touching which
Inventory you are presently assigned to perform or at furthest, at or before the second Tuesday in August next
following, on an account within twelvemonths from the date of these presents, and lastly we do hereby by Confute
Ordain and appoint you the said Lawrence Crawford, Heir of all and singular the goods Chattels & Credits
of the said deceased. signed by Order of Court this tenth day of June, in the 3rd year of their Majesties King
and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety one.

To know all men by these presents that we Lawrence Crawford James Henderson Sr. James Somers of the County
of Somerset and Province of Maryland Jun. do acknowledge & confess our selves to owe debts indebted unto their
Majesties Wm. & Mary by the Grace of God of England for the just sum of two hundred pound Sterling money of
England, which we promise to pay to their Majesties their Heirs or Assignors, and for the true performance of the same
we well and truly paid we bind us and ours of us our Heirs Exors and Assigns by these presents. In testimony
whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 23rd day of July in the 3rd year of their Majesties. Reign
