we bind us and each of us by this self and for the whole firmly by these presents sealed with
our seals and dated the 11th day of June in the 3rd year of their Majesties reign and in the year
of our Lord God One thousand six hundred ninety one and one and one

THE CONDITION of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Stephen Luffe do with
and truly serve their Majesties their Heirs and Successors in the Office of Justice Sheriff of Somerset County and
shall render unto their said Majesties and other their Majesties Officers a true faithful and perfect account of all
and singular their Majesties Rents and other fees and dues due and owing by the said County in the said County
unto the said Justice Sheriff of the said County of Somerset, and shall faithfully collect the same, and the acc^t
to their said Majesties Heirs and Successors for the Rents and fines forfeitures or other dues belonging to their
Majesties and also the account of all fees dues or sums of money for Rents or fees due to any of their Majesties
Officers within the said Province aforesaid and shall pass & give an acc^t of at the City of St. Marys in the said Province
in his own proper person by the first Tuesday in April next ensuing the date hereof, And in all other things
as Sheriff of the said County shall behave himself well and honestly as well towards their said Majesties as to all
other persons whatsoever, then this Obligation to be void otherwise to be and remain in full power
force and virtue
