I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel: David Minister at Snow Hill in the County and Province aforesaid five thousand pounds of p^{er}che, to be payed within twelve months after my decease to the said Samuel: David or his Order. I give and bequeath unto my friend: Mathew Minister of the Gospell at Hobok Down within the sd County and Province five thousand pounds of p^{er}che, to be payed to him or his Order within twelve months next after my decease. I give & bequeath unto my friend: William Minister of the Gospell at Monodou in the County & Province aforesaid five thousand pounds of p^{er}che, to be payed to him or to his Order within twelve months next after my decease. I give & bequeath unto my wellbelov'd friend Robert: Warrin of Monodou, the sum of ten thousand pounds of p^{er}che to be payed immediately after my decease unto the said Robert: Warrin. or his Order without remission within the sd County and Province. I give and bequeath all the rest of my goods Chattells, debts, house, Land and all other things belonging to me in any manner of way whatsoever, as well as in this aforesaid Province both at home and now abroad unto my trusty and wellbelov'd friend Majo: Robert: King of Monodou in the County & Province aforesaid to his heirs assignes and I do so John: Galbraith, do by these presents constitute, ordain & appoint my wellbelov'd friend Majo: Robert: King aforesaid my whole & sole Executor & Administrator, duly & truly to execute & performe that my last will and testament in Confirmation and full assurance, of the true aboves written, that is my last will & Testament of the sd John: Galbraith. have been unto my hand & fixed my seal at Monodou this day and year first aboves written.

Maryland Somerset County for William & Mary by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King & Queen defendours of the faith etc. to Majo: Robert King of the aforesaid County greeting. Whereas John: Galbraith of this County deceased, did by his last will and Testament bequeath unto Majo: Robert: King full and sole Executor, we do therefore grant unto you the sd Robert: King full power and authority to dem^o all and singular the goods Chattells and Credits of the said deceased and to demand collect and receive and in legall manner require and receive all and all manner of debts and duties due and owing to the said deceased, and well & faithfully to dispose of the same. And out of the goods Chattells and Credits of the said deceased, whiche have may or shall come to your hands or possession well and truly to pay the debts due by the said deceased so far forth as the same will extend and the law will charge you according to the true value of the sum thereof, you having first taken your Oath well and truly to dem^o the same, and to make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattells and Credits of the said deceased, whiche have may or shall come to your hands possession or knowledge (appraised in money) and a true and just account of and upon your dem^o thereon and to exhibit the same into our County Court whiche wills are proved according to power given by a certain Ordinance of Assembly lawfully authorized bearing witness Inventionary you are presently assigned to performe, or at furthest at or before the second last day in January next ensuing and an account within twelve months from the date of these presents. And lastly we do hereby constitute, ordain and appoint you & the said Robert: King dem^o of all and singular the goods Chattells and Credits of the said deceased and signed & Order of Court the 8th day of September in the third year of the sd Kings Majesty and in the year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred ninety one.
