The Deposition of William Downey aged thirty three years or thereabouts saith that about the 29th
day of Aprill last past being at Snow Hill, at Mr John Dorman's Store; and making there of some goods
in Order to deal, it was proposed to the Dornant by Francis Gombind to give him Credit in ...
for six hundred shobout six and a half pounds of tobacco which Gombind had by bill and had ready for
him: where I requested of the said Dorman: whether he would readily and freely receive the same, and
that if it were for a farre greater quantity he would receive the same, and with that was answered
... charged the Dornant to deliver for the same; and gave the said Gombind Credit, who thereupon delivered
me of, and from the said debt before witness, and gave me in my bill. The Dornant being ...
