 Goult had sold him the said Dorman: the so Goult blaming ~~the~~ Dorman that he kept
 him so long waiting there: and that he had not his goods sent down by the said Dorman's
 Dorman replied why he would still send them for him and they should be sent down, and upon
 that would find a box he missed of a Chest that he had for the said Goult in Order to
 serve the interest of the goods in, where the so Goult was to receive of the said Dorman for the
 tobacco above: where after Chest given by the said Dorman to the so Goult for six hundred
 shobonly six and a half pounds of tobacco for William Dorman upon a Saturday afternoon
 the said Goult his Inventory of his goods and the goods were called over thereby of Dorman
 witness of every particular that he had lost (as he said) his proportion according to quantity
 his tobacco would amount to; to sixty five shoball articles as was sold over before the Dorman
 and shoball others: the so Goult neither objection against the price nor the goodness
